4	During the Title V permit renewal process, we commonly encounter permits to install that have old or otherwise superseded applicable requirements. As an example, an underlying PTI with 17-07 and 17-11(A) [or (B)] requirements, where now 17-11(C) is the applicable rule. In order to ensure that the underlying PTI is harmonized with the PTO and reflects the correct applicable requirements the PTI (because the underlying requirements don't expire) must be modified. Who is responsible for initiating that modification? Currently SEDO requires them to submit a new PBR form for each new location rather than an ITR form.
