| 1 | <p>If a company submitted a Title V application before June 2008 and then adds new EUs to the application or submits a renewal application, they need to revise and update the Applicable Requirements section. Old applications were migrated referring to an attachment containing a PDF version of the application. That attachment is automatically deleted when a customer creates a new application. However, if they don't update that section the text will remain stating "see attached". The applicable requirements section was redesigned in Air Services such that they don't require the same things. In other words, if after they submit the Title V application you still don't have a complete applicable requirements section, they need to complete it.</p> | Engel-Ishida |
| 2 | <p>Admin Mods and the need for a Permit Strategy Write-Up. The software at this point only sees that it is a draft PTI or PTIO and thus thinks it needs a permit strategy write-up. We talked about a specific type of admin mod write up that we decided was not needed. | 4 | <p>What to do if a facility is in fact shutdown but you cannot get letter from entity.</p> <p>Part of the answer place topic (2266) states, "In order to permanently shut down a facility Ohio EPA must receive a request and signed certification from the authorized official, as defined in OAC rule 3745-31-04(B) for non-Title V facilities, or the responsible official, as defined in OAC rule 3745-77-01 for Title V facilities. This notification can be a part of filling another reporting requirement, such as the Non-Title V FER."</p> <p>What if we can't get that? How should the DOLAA proceed?</p> | Ahern/Engel-Ishida |
| 5 | <p>Anne Chamberlain - Portsmouth</p> <p>We got a couple of blue cards back for facility's marked as zero emissions or 0-10 tpy and the facility has not been installed yet or will not be installed at all . The facilities were mark was "not installed' in Stars 2. Why is correspondence (ie. PER letters, blue cards etc) sent to facilities that are identified as 'Not installed' ? Does a note or something need to be added to the facility profile indicating that no correspondence should be sent? If so, can DO/LAA add this? | 6 | <p>Brad Miller - HCDOES</p> <p>The Cincinnati area was recently designated as attainment for the 1997 Ozone standard. The 2008 ozone standard is now being reconsidered. In evaluating the ozone data, the Cincinnati area is non-attainment for the 2008 standard. Is the Cincinnati area considered attainment or non-attainment for Ozone/VOC at the present time? In looking at the USPEA Ozone Reconsideration Fact Sheet it states permitting of new and modified air pollution sources follow the PSD program for the 2008 ozone standards.</p> | Hopkins |
