3	<p>Alberta Mellon, HCDOES</p> <p>We currently have a FEPTIO facility that requested that we make two of their emission units portable. Both EU's are portable crushers. Following Engineering Guide 44, we assigned new facility ID's for each portable unit. In Stars2, each new portable facility is classified Non Title V (NTV). 4	<p>Kelly Kanoza, Canton</p> <p>If a facility applies for a permit for 3 EUs (F001, P001, P002), and F001 qualifies for a general permit, and the other 2 EUs do not, are we required to request the facility to submit general permit forms for the F001 and issue 2 permits or do we need to recommend that they apply for it? However, if the facility wants all 3 EUs to be in the same permit, do we issue all 3 as a traditional permit, or should we still request the appropriate forms and issue the 2 permits (general and traditional)?</p>	Erica Engel-Ishida/Mike Hopkins
