

Changes to See in Stars2 v. 1.28

1. Select PTIO Renewal Period

In the last version of Stars2 we added a check box to the PTIO Permit Detail screen. It allowed you indicate if the permit would not be an FEPTIO but would still need a 5-year renewal cycle. An enhancement was needed such that a user could not select more than one conflicting option in this area. Therefore, the structure below is now implemented on a PTIO Permit Detail Page:

Permit Information

- PTIO with 10 Year Renewal
- Not Federally Enforceable PTIO (FEPTIO) yet 5 Year Renewal
- FEPTIO with 5 Year Renewal
- FEPTIO to avoid Title V

The user must indicate which of the three options applies to the PTIO being processed. If the third radio button indicating an FEPTIO is selected, the user must still indicate if the FEPTIO being processed will keep the facility out of the Title V permitting program.

2. Permit Description Increased in the Daily Issuance Log

The daily issuance log that is attached to a DAPC permit issuance e-mail has been modified such that it will expand to display the entire permit description.

3. Request Administrative Permit Modification (RAPM) for Title V Permits Allows Insignificant EUs

If an insignificant EU was included in a final Title V permit that now requires an Administrative Permit Amendment (APA), Air Services was not allowing that EU to be included in the request. That has been corrected.

4. "MACT" to "MACT/GACT"

On the Permit Detail page wherever the selection of "MACT" appears it now is displayed as "MACT/GACT". In addition, if that box is checked on the Permit Detail page for a PTI or PTIO a "Yes" will appear next to "MACT/GACT" in the applicability table on the cover letter.

5. Mgmt Reports > PER Overdue Report

A new query tool has been created to replace a PDF report that was available. You can now go to the Mgmt Reports tab and select PER Overdue Report from the second level menu. If you do this and choose a county or DO/LAA, a list will be generated of those facilities and emissions units that have an overdue PER. As with all data grids in Stars2, you can export this list to Excel.

6. TVCC Overdue Tasks No Longer Generated

Tasks were being generated every so often informing users when a Title V Compliance Certification (TVCC) was overdue. Unfortunately we never got it fine tuned to the point where they were 100% reliable. Therefore, we have turned that function off and will be replacing it with a report that can be run, similar to a PER Overdue Report, only for TVCC. Look for that in a future deployment.

7. Duplicate Facility ID Results Corrected

You may have noticed that upon searching for a facility on the Facilities tab, two rows may have appeared rather than one. This bug was fixed in this release.
