Dear Mrs. Cahill:

On March 31, 2010, Ohio EPA, CDO (Central District Office), DHWM (Division of Hazardous Waste Management) staff (myself) investigated a complaint filed against Star Jet Motor Sports. The complaint alleged waste automotive fluids were spilled on the ground from a drum.

CDO staff arrived on site at 11:30 AM, I introduced myself to you and your husband Dick Cahill and informed you Ohio EPA had received a complaint and the nature of that complaint as stated above. Star Jet Motor Sports is a racing team and conducts maintenance of the race cars including body and paint work. Other vehicles such as motor homes and trailers associated with the race team are also maintained on site.

We conducted a complaint investigation with Mr. Cahill's help. There was no evidence of used oil spills in the yard or around the 55 gallon accumulation drum. During the complaint investigation we identified the following violation of Ohio's used oil rules.

1. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22 (C), Used oil Labeling:** Containers, above ground tanks, and fill pipes used for underground tanks must be clearly labeled or marked with the words "Used Oil".
 - (a) At the time of the complaint investigation Star Jet Motor Sports did not have the 55 gallon drum which accumulates used oil labeled with the words "used oil".
 - (b) Star Jet Motor Sports labeled the 55 gallon drum which accumulates used oil with the words "used oil" during the inspection.
- Star Jet Motor Sports is returned to compliance for the violation of OAC 3734-279-22 (C). Star Jet Motor Sports should make an effort in the future to keep the used oil container labeled and closed.

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The collected used oil is burned in a less than half a million BTU/ hour space heater with exhaust gasses vented outside. Oil spills inside the garages are cleaned up with oil dry and disposed as solid waste. Gasoline is always burned in the cars. Economy Lacquer Thinner is used to clean the paint guns and PPG paint is generally used on the vehicles. This results in a waste which has D001, D035, F003 and F005 hazardous waste codes. The hazardous waste is kept in five gallon cans and then shipped in 55 gallon drums. Less than 100 gallons of this waste are shipped each year to Petro-Chem Processing, 421 Lycast, MI 48214 for fuels blending prior to energy recovery at another site.

In the event oil is spilled on the ground it should be cleaned up and clean dirt or fill placed in the area. There were no tire piles at the site. All tires were stored indoors.

From the information gathered during the complaint investigation there was no evidence to support the complaint. We have enclosed a list of used oil recyclers as requested and information on management of fluorescent lamps.
