Dear Mr. Gajdosik:

On February 28, 2008, a Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) was conducted at Marathon Petroleum Company's Marietta Terminals No. 1 and 2. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Marathon's compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Present for the inspection were John Gajdosik representing Marathon and Stephen Wells representing Ohio EPA, Division of Surface Water, Southeast District Office. No wastewater samples were collected as part of the inspection. A copy of my inspection report is attached.


1. The storm water runoff from the dike areas of the facility make up the majority of the discharge. The diked area discharges are controlled to help prevent any product from being discharged out of the outfall.
2. Marathon is planning on expanding north tank farm area to include more storage. If more than one acre of land will be disturbed during this construction, Marathon will need to apply for a Construction General Storm Water Permit for this activity. Also, Marathon will need to submit a letter to this office describing the increase in discharge due to a larger dike area being drained.

In conclusion, Marathon Petroleum Company, LLC appeared to be in compliance with its NPDES Permit at the time of the inspection.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner.
