On June 22, 2010, I conducted an inspection of the Shelly Materials' Price Inland Terminal in Belpre. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Shelly's compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. A copy of my inspection report is attached.

The facility appeared to be compliance with its NPDES Permit at the time of the inspection. You indicated the solids retention pond would be cleaned in the near future due to the build-up of solids. Also, the monitoring of the ground water monitoring wells located on-site was discussed. I am still trying to locate the actual monitoring requirements that were required in the original PTI issued for the facility. I will contact you with the monitoring requirements in the near future.


