Dear Mayor and Council:

On November 9, 2010, a Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) was conducted at the City of Marietta's Water Treatment Plant. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the City's compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Present for the inspection were Jeff Kephart representing the City of Marietta and Stephen Wells representing Ohio EPA, Division of Surface Water, Southeast District Office. A copy of my inspection report is attached.

As a result of my inspection, I have the following comments:

1. A meeting was held to discuss the necessary forms and information that needed to be submitted for the NPDES Permit renewal application.
2. The discharge from the interceptor wells was observed. All discharges appeared to be of good quality.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention programs. 


