Dear Mr. Schall:

On September 14, 2010, a Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) was conducted at Keystone Terminals – Ohio River Dock. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Keystone's compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Present for the inspection were Wayne Gehringer representing Keystone and Stephen Wells representing Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office, Division of Surface Water. No wastewater samples were collected as part of the inspection. A copy of my inspection is attached.

As a result of my inspection, I have the following comments:

1. The runoff pond was cleaned out the previous week before the inspection. The material removed from the pond are added to one of the existing storage piles on-site to dewater. This is acceptable.
2. The runoff pond is large enough that a discharge does not typically occur. The water is allowed to evaporate off.
3. The barge loading facility was also inspected as a part of the inspection. The conveyor belt to the river and out to barge loading area had spill protection.

In conclusion, Keystone Terminals – Ohio River Dock appeared to be in compliance with its NPDES Permit at the time of the inspection.


