Dear Commissioners:

We have reviewed your monthly discharge monitoring reports for the period October 2007 through January 2008 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance and/or deficiencies are as follows:

On October 9, 2007, you entered into a Consent Agreement with the State of Ohio in Case No. 06-CV-00137. The Consent Order requires you to submit a stipulated penalty of \$100 per violation for any violations of your NPDES discharge permit. See Part VIII (item 21). Payments due shall be made within forty-five (45) days from the date of the failure to meet the effluent limitation, and shall be accompanied by a written explanation of the effluent violation (see Part VIII, item 25).

Therefore, you must submit a penalty of \$200 for the above two violations. You must submit a check for this amount made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio" to:


