Dear Mr. Carroll:

On February 11, 2009, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection (CEI) at the Plastic Compounders, Inc. facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine compliance with the terms and conditions of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit number 0IQ00008*ED. This inspection was also conducted as a pre-permit inspection to verify no manufacturing processes have changed to aide in the drafting of your renewal. The inspection was conducted in your presence and the findings are summarized below.

At the time of my inspection, the contact and non-contact cooling water chiller unit was in operation and recycling all cooling water. Information was provided by you documenting the daily evaporative water losses and the general cooling water process. Normal extrusion processes involve the chiller cooling units which recycle all of the cooling water and makeup water is added daily for evaporative losses. The discharge permit is maintained for emergency situations when the chiller unit may go off line and the combined cooling water would be discharged. At the time of my inspection all normal operations were fully operational and no cooling water discharge was observed.
