Dear Mr. Gordon:

We have received your self-monitoring report covering the month of January 2007 for the Buffalo Duke and Duchess Store. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. Three frequency violations were reported as a result of the failure to submit a monthly ammonia sample and two dissolved oxygen readings for the month.

Please submit within **10** days upon receipt of this letter as to the reasons for the above permit violations and actions being taken to prevent further occurrences. Review of our files also show that you have not yet submitted an NPDES renewal application which was due in February. Please submit two copies of NPDES application Forms 1, 2E, and 2S with a check made out to "Treasurer - State of Ohio" in the amount of \$200. The renewal application packet should also include two copies of the Antidegradation Addendum form.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
