Dear Mr. Swingle:

On March 2, 2010, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Owens-Illinois Glass Container, Inc. located in Zanesville, Ohio. Rich Stewart, DHWM/OEPA/SEDO, assisted me with the inspection. You represented Owens-Illinois Glass Container, Inc. and accompanied me during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Owens-Illinois' compliance with NPDES Permit Number 01N00044\*HD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:


1. The floor drains in your facility were not marked and a schematic of the discharge points was not available. All drains are to be marked and a schematic of the discharge points is to be completed as soon as possible. Provide the EPA with one copy of the schematic.
2. The parking lot area is to be swept periodically to eliminate debris from entering the storm sewer. **Also**, the catch basin above the weir tank needs to be raised to ground level and a lid with smaller openings installed. This will prevent debris from entering the basin.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report. Owens-Illinois should take the appropriate actions to maintain the facility for compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

Please respond to this letter by April 16, 2010.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. 
