Dear Mr. Pappas:

On September 4, 2009, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at the Lumi Lite Candle Co., Inc. located in Norwich, Ohio. Earlier in the day, I had reviewed your DMR's and other records with Mr. Mike Wisecarver of Wisecarver Environmental. I was accompanied by you on the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Lumi-Lite's compliance with NPDES Permit Number 01M00021*AD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, the facility appears to be in compliance with its' NPDES permit. No apparent violations were found at the time of inspection.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates the areas evaluated during the inspection.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. 
