On September 4, 2009, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at West Muskingum School District Wastewater Plant located in Zanesville, Ohio. Mike Wisecarver represented West Muskingum Schools and accompanied me during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine West Muskingum's compliance with NPDES Permit Number OPT00061*BD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I found no apparent violations.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates the areas evaluated during the inspection. West Muskingum should take the appropriate actions to maintain the facility for compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). 
