Dear Mr. Winland:

On April 23, 2010, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Powhatan Mine No. 7 located in Clarington, Ohio. You represented Central Ohio Coal Company and accompanied me during the inspection. We also met with Chuck Schwaben of DOVES. DOVES is located in the old maintenance shop at the mine. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Central Ohio Coal's compliance with NPDES Permit Number 0IL00072*FD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:


1. DOVES was requested to install a high water alarm on its sewage system. They complied and sent Ohio EPA a confirmatory email with pictures on April 30, 2010.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report. I found no apparent violations. Central Ohio Coal should take the appropriate actions to maintain the facility in compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention




