On August 12, 2009, I conducted an inspection of the 5314 (B) Mill St. facility in Orient, Ohio to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). This inspection was conducted as part of a complaint filed on your former tenants of 5314 (B) Mill St., Engine Parts & Supply. As the property owner and landlord you are receiving this letter as a notification of the obligations now associated with this site. I sent you a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter on September 8, 2009 specifying the violations observed during the inspection. I returned to the facility on August 18, 2011 to do a facility walk through.

Upon completing this walk through, Hale Imaging Systems has now abated all violations discovered during the August 12, 2009 investigation as listed below.
