Re: Return To Compliance-Jiffy Lube Store # 2400 and #1306

Dear Mr. Pettengill:

On November 6, 2007, Larry Dickerson and I representing Ohio EPA visited your Jiffy Lube Stores as a follow-up to the complaint investigation. The purpose of the re-inspection was to document your return to compliance for the violations described in Ohio EPA's June 22, 2007 letter. The following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste rules have been abated:

Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators., OAC 3745-279-22(c)(1): This rule states that containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil". During the inspection, it was noted that the containers used to collect and transfer used oil located at your stores are now labeled as required by this rule. This violation has been abated.

Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators., OAC 3745-279-22(c)(2): This rule states that piping used to transfer used oil to underground storage tanks shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil". During the inspection, it was noted that the piping used to transfer used oil to the underground storage tank at Jiffy Lube Store # 1306 is now labeled as required by this rule with the words "Used Oil". This violation has been abated.
