On November 18 and 22, 2010, Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHWM) conducted follow-up inspections of Lakes Automotive located at 318 North Tenth Street, Hamilton, Ohio. The follow-up inspections were conducted as a result of violations discovered during an initial September 30, 2010 complaint investigation. These violations are included in my October 7, 2010 letter addressed to you. During both the November 18 and 22, 2010 inspections, I represented Ohio EPA and you represented Lakes Automotive.

The November 18 and 22, 2010 inspections reveals that Lakes Automotive has now abated all violations discovered during the September 30, 2010 complaint investigation as listed below.


