Dear Mr. Kehl:

On June 21, 2007, I revisited your facility for a return to compliance inspection. The initial investigation took place on May 9, 2007. I noted that you had labeled the used oil containers with the words "Used Oil", and had removed the used oil absorbent material from the spill area near the aboveground used oil tank. As such, you have returned to compliance with the following:

OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1), Used Oil Label
OAC 3745-279-22(D), Response to releases

Please attempt to keep the area near the aboveground tank free of spilled oil so that you may remain in compliance with the used oil regulations.
