**Re: Notice of Violation
WPAFB Area A/C OH2570090066, Greene County, LQG**

Dear Mr. Selby,

This letter is being sent in response to WPAFB's letter dated July 8, 2008 by Mark L. Mays, Chief of Environmental Management Division received by Ohio EPA July 9, 2008.

Based on Ohio EPA's review of the July 8, 2008 letter we found WPAFB in violation of the following hazardous waste regulation.

**Manifests
Ohio Administrative Code 3745-52-20**

This regulation requires a generator who transports or offers for transportation hazardous waste for off site treatment, storage, or disposal to prepare a uniform hazardous waste manifest before transporting the hazardous waste off site.


According to WPAFB's July 8, 2008 letter hazardous waste that had been generated at Area A/C was later found at the TSD/ Area B without a uniform hazardous waste manifest. Therefore, WPAFB Area A/C was in violation of OAC 3745-52-20 for transporting or offering for transportation a hazardous waste for off site treatment, storage, or disposal without first preparing a uniform hazardous waste manifest.

WPAFB's cover letter states that they are conducting a thorough assessment of their RCRA program to prevent this type of error in the future. To abate this violation, provide a written response to this letter within 30 days which explains the findings of the "assessment of the RCRA program" and explains what, if any, actions WPAFB has taken to prevent a similar incident from occurring in the future.
