**Re: Partial Return to Compliance
M&H Farm Equipment, Greene County, CEG**

Mr. Bill Morris,

On October 4, 2007 Pam Hull and I conducted an inspection at M & H Farm Equipment (M & H) in Jamestown, Ohio to determine compliance with Ohio EPA's June 22, 2007 notice of violation (nov). You were present during the inspection.

During the inspection I noted that you had responded to a release of used oil, stopped further release of used oil, and had dug up contaminated soil and gravel.

May this letter serve to notify you that M & H remains in violation of OAC 3745-279-22 (D) because M&H has not properly disposed of the contaminated soil and gravel. To abate the violation M&H must properly dispose of the contaminated soil and gravel. I recommend contacting landfills to determine if the waste will be accepted. Properly dispose of the contaminated soil within 30 days of this letter and obtain a receipt which documents proper disposal. Within 45 days of this letter provide a letter to this office which explains how M & H has abated this violation and attach a receipt which indicates proper disposal.

If you have questions about how to comply with this letter please contact me at 937-285-6082. Failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not preclude M&H from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
