Dear Mr. Taylor:

On May 30, 2007, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) conducted a compliance evaluation of Transcontinental Miami Valley(TMV) to determine your return to compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations for the violations described in the April 24, 2007 letter.

TMV has returned to compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-273-13(D)(1). TMV manages universal waste lamps in containers that are structurally sound, adequate to prevent breakage, and compatible with the contents of the lamps. Additionally, the containers were observed to be closed.

TMV has returned to compliance with OAC 3745-273-14(E). The packages containing universal waste lamps observed at TMV are now properly labeled.

TMV has abated the violations observed during the April 11, 2007 inspection as documented during this inspection and your follow-up e-mail correspondence. Should you have any questions, please contact me at (937) 285-6083.
