Ohio EPA is in receipt of American Compressed Steel's March 1, 2010 letter responding to Ohio EPA's October 19, 2009 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. On March 16, 2010 Ohio EPA conducted a return to compliance (RTC) inspection to ensure the violation and general concern had been abated. During the inspection Gary Vernon, Gary Flick, and Ken Weber represented American Compressed Steel and I represented Ohio EPA.

My review of American Compressed Steel's response along with the inspection reveals that American Compressed Steel has demonstrated abatement of the violation and general concern noted in Ohio EPA's October 19, 2010 Notice of Violation.
