Thank you for your August 18, 2010 and October 8, 2010 responses to Ohio EPA's June 14, 2010 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. The documentation you submitted included proof of ballast recycling at Rumpke and disposal records for your used oil-containing soil and sludge at Petro Environmental. I also spoke with Chris Tucker of Petro Environmental on October 26, 2010 and confirmed that your application to dispose of this used oil waste was accepted.

My June 14, 2010 site visit while hand-delivering your NOV letter and review of the documentation reveals that CWR has **abated all violations** listed below and the ballast concern discovered during the April 21, 2010 and April 23, 2010 complaint investigation.


