

RE: Complaint Investigation at Rosemont Industries Inc. and Notice of Violation

Dear Mr. Majors:

On April 24, 2007 and May 15, 2007, Ohio EPA conducted a complaint investigation at Rosemont Industries Inc. (RI) located in Reading. The investigation performed by the Ohio EPA was the result of a complaint received by this Agency on March 14, 2007. The complaint alleged that RI stores thousands of gallons of hazardous chemicals and that some of them are leaking. I represented Ohio EPA on both dates and Jeff Smith also represented Ohio EPA on May 15, 2007. Ohio EPA was accompanied by Kim Fladung from the Reading Fire Department on April 24, 2007 and by Mike Cappel of the Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD) on May 15, 2007. In this matter, you represented RI.

A summary of our investigation is as follows:

- With the exception of some repair work on RI manufactured equipment, RI's various manufacturing processes have been ceased, and RI does not plan on resuming these operations.
- Ohio EPA did not find any leaking chemicals.
- RI currently stores numerous vats and containers of raw materials and process chemicals. Based on the fact that facility operations have been ceased and the condition of some of the materials in storage, there does not appear to be plans to use much of these materials.
- On April 24, 2007, you stated that you would be working with a vendor to have wastes characterized and removed. As of May 15, 2007, this activity had not occurred.

- Between the April 24, 2007 visit and the May 15, 2007 visit, one vat of process chemicals had been discharged to the sanitary sewer without proper characterization and without permission of MSD.
- Several containers of used oil were found in storage without proper labeling.

Based on these findings, Ohio EPA has identified the following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste laws:

**Hazardous Waste Determination
(OAC 3745-52-11)**

Any person who generates a waste must determine if the waste is a hazardous waste. A copy of this rule is included in its entirety.

RI failed to evaluate its waste (drums, vats, process lines) to determine if it is hazardous.

RI must immediately submit an inventory of your chemical materials **within 10 days upon your receipt of this letter. Additionally, do not dispose of any further material down the sewer without first contacting MSD.**

List the quantity, material type, storage container description and material description of any chemical material that remains at RI. Identify which of these materials will be declared waste, provide a schedule for hazardous waste evaluation and removal, and identify where it will be shipped. For materials that are identified as useable product or raw material, provide a description of what it will be used for and by when it will be used.

We are recommending that RI move all of these identified drums in a common area (e.g., Area F), grouping like materials together. Also, we recommend that all used oil is stored together and that you initiate removal of all of your RCRA empty drums (i.e., those that contain less than 1 inch of material).


**Used Oil Labeling Requirements
[OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1)]**

Containers used to store used oil at generator facilities must be labeled with the words "Used Oil".

RI failed to label its used oil containers with the words "Used Oil".

RI must immediately label its containers with the words "Used Oil" and submit documentation to this office for review **within 10 days upon your receipt of this letter.**

For future reference, we are notifying RI of Ohio's Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) requirements. Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-




352-05(E) defines "Cessation of Regulated Operations" as the discontinuation or termination of regulated operations or the finalizing of any transactions or proceeding through which those operations are discontinued. A handbook is enclosed for your review.

In addition to the regulatory violations identified above, Ohio EPA has concerns related to the nature and quantity of materials being stored, the condition of the building, and the proximity of the facility to a residential neighborhood. It is therefore important that we receive from you a written response that expresses an intent and ability to conduct the necessary identification and removal of hazardous waste **within 10 days upon your receipt of this letter.**
