Thank you for your March 15, 2010 reply to Ohio EPA's February 12, 2010 Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRCT) letter. Additionally, Matt Schnetzer sent me an e-mail on May 7, 2010 providing photo documentation for violations #3-#6. I requested this photo documentation on April 30, 2010.

Therefore, upon review of UCEC's documentation, Ohio EPA had determined that UCEC has abated **all violations** discovered during Ohio EPA's December 17, 2009 and December 21, 2009 compliance evaluation inspection (CEI) as listed below.


UCEC had already returned to compliance with violations # 1, #2 and #7.
