
Dear Mr. Jacobs,

Ohio EPA is in receipt of D&T Body Shop's April 13, 2010 letter responding to Ohio EPA's August 7, 2009 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. Ohio EPA is also in receipt of results of analysis dated October 14, 2009 and conducted by Belmont labs on behalf of D&T Body shop relative to spent paint booth filters and spent water base gun cleaning solvent. On October 21, 2009 and March 09, 2010 via email Ohio EPA notified D&T Body shop of a need to provide written response to the August 7, 2009 NOV. On March 09, 2010 Ohio EPA conducted a return to compliance (RTC) inspection to ensure the violation and general concern had been abated. During the inspection you represented D&T Body Shop and I represented Ohio EPA.

My review of D&T Body Shop's response along with the inspection reveals that D&T Body Shop has demonstrated abatement of the violation and general concern noted in Ohio EPA's August 7, 2009 Notice of Violation.
