

Dear Mr. LaMantia:

On October 22, 2009, Jeff Smith and I conducted an inspection of Multi-Service's Dayton, Ohio facility. Mel Tatman represented Multi-Service during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether Multi-Service had abated the remaining violation cited in the October 8, 2009, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. We also inspected the hazardous waste totes.

Based on this inspection, Ohio EPA has determined that Multi-Service has adequately abated the following violation discovered during the October 8, 2009, inspection:

**2. Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC 3745-279-22(C)**

However, Multi-Service failed to have seven (7) hazardous waste totes properly shipped off-site before the 90-day expiration date. **This is a violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.02(E)(2) and (F), which state in part:**

- (E)(2) No person shall establish or operate a hazardous waste facility for the storage, treatment, or disposal of any hazardous waste, without a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit issued in accordance with section 3734.05 of the Revised Code.
- (F) No person shall store, treat, or dispose of hazardous waste identified or listed under this chapter and rules adopted under it, regardless of whether generated on or off the premises where the waste is stored, treated, or disposed of. . . except at or to any permitted hazardous waste facility.

This is an on-going violation due to Multi-Service's continued storage of hazardous waste in the hazardous waste tank since approximately December 2008. As stated in

the July 22, 2009, NOV, since Multi-Service violated ORC 3734.02(E) and (F), Multi-Service is subject to all applicable general facility standards found in OAC Chapters 3745-54 and 55. Additionally, at any time Ohio EPA may assert its right to have Multi-Service begin facility-wide cleanup pursuant to the Corrective Actions process under Ohio law.

We also discussed with Mr. Tatman the need to update the contingency plan to reflect the current activities at the site. The current contingency plan describes a solvent recovery process that utilizes a 12,185 gallon clean solvent tank, a 12,185 gallon dirty solvent tank, and a 3,800 gallon sludge tank. Multi-Service has discontinued the solvent recovery process so neither the clean solvent tank nor the dirty solvent tank is used any more. The sludge tank is currently used to store used oil. OAC 3745-65-54(C) states in part, "The contingency plan must be immediately amended whenever the facility changes - in its design, construction, operation, maintenance, or other circumstances - the response necessary in an emergency." Local emergency response need to know the specific activities conducted and the accurate locations of materials at the facility. Within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter, please submit an updated contingency plan.
