RE: Continued Compliance Evaluation Inspection - OHR000014605

Dear Mr. LaMantia:

Thank you for assisting Jeff Smith and me during our October 8, 2009, inspection of Multi-Service's Dayton, Ohio facility. The focus of the inspection was on the storage tanks used for the dry cleaning process. We also inspected the hazardous waste totes and the hazardous waste tank. Two storage tanks used for dry cleaning (one labeled clean solvent, one labeled dirty solvent) are no longer used by Multi-Service. The tanks are empty. A third tank, labeled sludge, is no longer used to store hazardous waste sludge. The tank now stores used oil.

Based on this inspection, Ohio EPA has determined that Multi-Service has violated the following hazardous waste regulations:

- 1. Accumulation time of hazardous waste, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-52-34(A)(2) and (A)(3):**  
(A)(2) The date upon which each period of accumulation and/or treatment begins is clearly marked and visible for inspection on each container;  
(A)(3) While being accumulated and/or treated on-site, each container and tank is labeled or marked clearly with the words "Hazardous Waste."

Multi-Service failed to comply with OAC 3745-52-34(A)(2) and (A)(3) by not properly labeling one hazardous waste tote with the accumulation date or with the words "Hazardous Waste." **Therefore, Multi-Service is in violation of OAC 3745-52-34(A)(2) and (A)(3).**

During the inspection, Multi-Service properly labeled and dated the tote. **Therefore, Multi-Service is no longer in violation of OAC 3745-52-34(A)(2) and (A)(3).**

2. **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC 3745-279-22(C):** Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities must be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

Multi-Service failed to comply with OAC 3745-279-22(C) by not properly labeling the used oil tank. **Therefore, Multi-Service is in violation of OAC 3745-279-22(C).** To return to compliance, properly label the used oil tank with the words "Used Oil."
