



RE: Ongoing Compliance Evaluation Inspection - OHR000014605

Dear Mr. LaMantia:

On August 7, 2009, Ohio EPA received Multi-Service's contingency plan in partial response to the Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated July 22, 2009. In the July 22, 2009, NOV Multi-Service was cited with several Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) violations. This letter addresses two of the citations; OAC 3745-65-52(A) and 3745-65-54(C).

OAC 3745-65-52(A) was cited because the contingency plan detailed notification of spills only for reportable quantities. The latest contingency plan, as in the originally submitted plan, contains section VI, Hazardous Material/Waste Emergency Response. Within section VI, paragraph D details procedures for responding to releases of hazardous materials and wastes but only in terms of reportable quantities, not in accordance with OAC 3745-65-52(A). Multi-Service did include a completely new section (section VII Emergency Procedures) that includes the proper notification information. There is no correlation between sections VI and VII. The contingency plan is confusing and could lead someone responding to a hazardous material or waste release to turn to the incorrect section, thereby not complying with the regulations. Please revise the plan to clearly detail the appropriate response to a hazardous waste release.

OAC 3745-65-54(C) was cited because the contingency plan must be amended whenever the facility changes its operation in a way that changes the response necessary in an emergency. Multi-Service's contingency plan details the facility's dry cleaning operation and the hazardous waste storage tanks associated with this operation. However, during the June 15, 2009, inspection, you explained that the dry

cleaning service is no longer operating and the tanks are no longer used. Please revise the plan to clearly detail the current operations at the facility.

Multi-Service continues to be in violation of OAC 3745-65-52(A) and 3745-65-54(C). To return to compliance, Multi-Service must update the contingency plan to include the above information. Submit the updated contingency plan to Ohio EPA within 14 days of receipt of this letter.
