





Dear Mr. LaMantia:

On June 4, 2009, and June 15, 2009, Ohio EPA conducted compliance evaluation inspections of Multi-Service's Dayton, Ohio facility. The purpose of the inspections was to determine Multi-Service's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745. of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Mel Tatman and Robert Jones represented Multi-Service on June 4, 2009. You represented Multi-Service on June 15, 2009. Jeff Smith and I represented Ohio EPA during the June 4, 2009, inspection. Jeff Stark and I represented Ohio EPA during the June 15, 2009, inspection. Based on the inspections, Ohio EPA has determined that Multi-Service has violated the following hazardous waste regulation:

1. Treatment, storage, and disposal facility, ORC 3734.02 (E)(2) and (F) state in part:

(E)(2) No person shall establish or operate a hazardous waste facility for the storage, treatment, or disposal of any hazardous waste, without a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit issued in accordance with section 3734.05 of the Revised Code.

(F) No person shall store, treat, or dispose of hazardous waste identified or listed under this chapter and rules adopted under it, regardless of whether generated on or off the premises where the waste is stored, treated, or disposed of. . .except at or to any permitted hazardous waste facility.

According to OAC 3745-52-34(B) a generator who, for more than ninety days, accumulates and/or conducts treatment of hazardous waste that is generated on-site is an operator of a storage and/or treatment facility. Multi-Service stored six

hazardous waste totes for more than ninety days. One hazardous waste tote was dated February 27, 2009, three were dated March 9, 2009, and two were dated March 13, 2009. Multi-Service did not have a hazardous waste pick up until June 12, 2009. **Therefore, Multi-Service is in violation of ORC 3734.02(E)(2) and (F).**

Since Multi-Service violated ORC 3734.02(E) and (F), Multi-Service is subject to all applicable general facility standards found in OAC Chapters 3745-54 and 55. Additionally, at any time Ohio EPA may assert its right to have Multi-Service begin facility-wide cleanup pursuant to the Corrective Actions process under Ohio law.

During the June 15, 2009, inspection I requested copies of the following information:

1. Contingency plan;
2. Hazardous waste manifests for 2008 and 2009;
3. Personnel training records for Robert Jones;
4. Emergency equipment inspection records;
5. Hazardous waste tank inspection records for October and November 2008; and
6. Hazardous waste storage tank information.

I will address the required tank information (#6) in a separate letter. The other information should be submitted to this office within 7 days of receipt of this letter. Additional violations may be cited based on a review of the requested information. Should you have any questions, please call me at (937) 285-6093.

Dear Ms. Hostetter:

On November 27, 2007, Ohio EPA issued a notice of violation letter to Pet Supplies Plus. The letter explained Pet Supplies Plus' violation of the hazardous waste determination regulation as found in the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-52-11. Ohio EPA requested a response from Pet Supplies Plus within 14 days of receipt of the letter. You received and signed for the certified letter on November 29, 2007. As of the date of this letter, Ohio EPA has received no response from Pet Supplies Plus.

Pet Supplies Plus remains in violation of the following Ohio hazardous waste regulation:

1. **Hazardous waste determination, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-52-11:** Any person who generates a waste, as defined in rule 3745-51-02 of the Administrative Code, must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste using the following method:
 - (A) He should first determine if the waste is excluded from regulation under rule 3745-51-04 of the Administrative Code.
 - (B) He must then determine if the waste is listed as a hazardous waste in rules 3745-51-30 to 3745-51-35 of the Administrative Code.
 - (C) For purposes of compliance with Chapter 3745-270 of the Administrative Code, or if the waste is not listed as a hazardous waste in rules 3745-51-30 to 3745-51-35 of the Administrative Code, the

generator must then determine whether the waste is identified in rules 3745-51-20 to 3745-51-24 of the Administrative Code by either:

- (1) Testing the waste according to the methods set forth in rules 3745-51-20 to 3745-51-24 of the Administrative Code, or according to an equivalent method approved by the Region V Administrator of U.S. EPA pursuant to 40 CFR 260.21; or
- (2) Applying knowledge of the hazardous characteristic of the waste in light of the materials or the processes used.

As requested in the November 27, 2007, notice of violation letter, Pet Supplies Plus must properly evaluate and determine whether the bulbs disposed of were hazardous waste or not. **Within 7 days of receipt of this letter, provide Ohio EPA with documentation of waste determination.**

Failure to properly evaluate bulbs prior to disposal may result in Ohio EPA referring Pet Supplies Plus for escalated enforcement. Should you have any questions please call me at (937) 285-6093.
