



RE: Complaint Investigation

Dear Ms. Hostetter:

Thank you for assisting me during my complaint investigation on November 5, 2007. The complaint alleged improper disposal of fluorescent bulbs by Pet Supplies Plus located at 508 E. Stroop Road. During the investigation, it was determined that Pet Supplies Plus changed out all fluorescent bulbs (approximately 300) in the building the previous month and disposed of the fluorescent bulbs in the dumpster. Therefore, Pet Supplies Plus is in violation of the following Ohio hazardous waste regulation:

1. **Hazardous waste determination, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-52-11:** Any person who generates a waste, as defined in rule 3745-51-02 of the Administrative Code, must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste using the following method:
 - (A) He should first determine if the waste is excluded from regulation under rule 3745-51-04 of the Administrative Code.
 - (B) He must then determine if the waste is listed as a hazardous waste in rules 3745-51-30 to 3745-51-35 of the Administrative Code.
 - (C) For purposes of compliance with Chapter 3745-270 of the Administrative Code, or if the waste is not listed as a hazardous waste in rules 3745-51-30 to 3745-51-35 of the Administrative Code, the generator must then determine whether the waste is identified in rules 3745-51-20 to 3745-51-24 of the Administrative Code by either:

- (1) Testing the waste according to the methods set forth in rules 3745-51-20 to 3745-51-24 of the Administrative Code, or according to an equivalent method approved by the Region V Administrator of U.S. EPA pursuant to 40 CFR 260.21; or
- (2) Applying knowledge of the hazardous characteristic of the waste in light of the materials or the processes used.

Pet Supplies Plus failed to comply with this regulation by not properly evaluating the bulbs prior to disposing of them. Pet Supplies Plus must properly evaluate and determine whether the bulbs disposed of were hazardous waste or not. Within 14 days of receipt of this letter, provide Ohio EPA with documentation of waste determination.

During the complaint investigation, I provided you with two guidance documents, "Fluorescent Lamps: What You Should Know" and "Universal Waste Rules for Handlers of Lamps." If you have any questions, please call me at (937) 285-6093.
