Re: Property at 3675 Wyse Road – Open Dumping of Drums – RTC

Dear Ms. VanHoose:

On April 16, 2010, Ohio EPA, Division of Hazardous Waste Management, sent a letter directing Spirit Life Church to dispose of the drums and containers of waste present at the church owned property at 3675 Wyse Road in Vandalia, Ohio. The letter cited a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-52-11, Hazardous Waste Determination.

Since then, with assistance from the Ohio EPA, Orphan Drum Program, the drums and containers of waste have been removed from the property and disposed of. This has abated the violation.

The services provided by the Orphan Drum Program were in addition to the assistance provided to the Spirit Life Church by the Ohio EPA, Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management, which removed approximately 400 tires from the site for the church.

As mentioned in the April 16, 2010 letter, there may be additional environmental issues if/when the site is redeveloped. Spirit Life Church must be aware that any waste generated during the redevelopment of the site must be evaluated per OAC 3745-52-11. If the waste is found to be hazardous then it must be stored, treated and/or disposed according to all applicable Ohio hazardous waste rules located in OAC Chapters 3745-49 through 3745-279.
