Dear Mr. Spurlock:

On May 12, 2008, Ohio EPA received a complaint submitted via USEPA's web site that Summit Towing, Inc. (STI) located at 4164 Gardendale in Dayton crushes cars and lets auto fluids be released to the ground. During my and Larry Dickerson's July 2, 2008 site visit, we observed containers to collect auto fluids near your car crushers. Also, we observed some evidence of sloppy handling practices surrounding the containers. On July 9, 2008, you faxed us your last 2 used oil disposal invoices (dated 4/24/08 and 1/28/08). Therefore, based upon our July 2, 2008 site visit and review of the invoices faxed on July 9, 2008, Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management **did not find any evidence that supported the complaint's allegations.**

However, I found the following violation of Ohio's hazardous waste laws:

***Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators
(OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1))***

Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil".

During the July 2, 2008 complaint investigation, STI failed to label its containers near your car crushers with the words "Used Oil".

STI must immediately label the containers collecting fluids from your car crushers with the words "Used Oil" and submit documentation in the form of a photograph to this office for review.


In order to correct this violation you must send me the required photo documentation within 15 days upon your receipt of this letter.
