Dear Mr. Spurlock:

Thank you for your response to Ohio EPA's July 11, 2008 Notice of Violation letter. You submitted a photo via e-mail on July 17, 2008, documenting that Summit Towing, Inc. (STI) labeled your used oil tank with the words "Used Oil". I was mistaken in my July 11, 2008 letter. STI only has one used oil tank (per our telephone conversation yesterday). You also labeled your used gasoline tank with the words "Used Gas". This is not an Ohio EPA requirement, but is a good management practice to know what's in each tank.

My inspection of this documentation regarding your used oil tank revealed that STI abated the violation discovered during the July 2, 2008 complaint investigation as listed below.
