Dear Mr. Vonbargen:

On February 26, 2009, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) conducted a return to compliance evaluation of Armor Metal Group Mason, Inc (Armor). The purpose of this inspection was to document your return to compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found under the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).


Weekly Inspections – OAC 3745-66-74

Armor has returned to compliance with OAC 3745-66-74 by conducting the required weekly inspections of the container accumulation area. These inspections are completed once every seven (7) day period and recorded in a log or summary.

Manifest Requirements

Hazardous waste manifests were reviewed during the inspection. No violations were found.

Armor presented information from their contractor demonstrating that the solvent from the parts washer is being handled as a "continued use" solvent. This material is being sent out on a bill of lading as a product replacement used by the contractor without any additional treatment or processing.
