**Re: Compliance Evaluation Inspection - Notice of Violation and Return to Compliance**  
**Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator**

Dear Ms. Cryder:

On June 4, 2009, Larry Dickerson, Robyn Fox, and I inspected the Lebanon Ford Lincoln Mercury Dealership located at 770 Columbus Avenue in Lebanon, Ohio to determine your compliance with Ohio's Hazardous Waste Laws as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

**Violation - Used Oil**

Generator Standards - Used Oil (OAC 3745-279-22)(C)

Used Oil must be stored in containers that are labeled with the words "Used Oil," as per OAC 3745-279-22 (C). Lebanon Ford Lincoln Mercury was in violation of this rule for not labeling the used oil tank. This violation was corrected at the time of the inspection, and is therefore **Returned to Compliance** at this time.

Enclosed, please see our Used Oil guidance sheet for Used Oil regulations.

The following is provided for your information only.

## **Generator Status**

Currently, this dealership generates Used Oil and may periodically generate hazardous waste. At the time of the inspection, no hazardous waste was being accumulated on site. Due to the amount generated in any given calendar month, this facility is currently a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator.

As a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator, you must ensure that:

- All wastes have been evaluated to determine whether or not they are hazardous;
- All wastes are managed and disposed of properly;
- All hazardous waste is shipped to a permitted hazardous waste facility, and;
- Records are maintained to show that all hazardous waste was shipped to a permitted facility.

For future reference, the level of regulatory requirements you will need to comply with depends on the amount of hazardous waste generated in any calendar month. Be aware that if you generate more than 100 Kg (~ 220 lbs or ½ drum) in any calendar month, more requirements will apply.

## **Oil Storage (Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (40 CFR Part 112.1(d)(2)(ii)) and Storage Requirements (OAC 3745-279-22))**

During the inspection, Mr. Young, Service Director, noted that he will be using the former paint booth as a storage area for oil product and used oil. We encourage you to take these steps. As a reminder, oil and used oil storage is also regulated by the Oil Pollution Prevention Act. This Act limits the amount that can be stored on site without a Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure Plan. The maximum allowable limits established by this Act is a total above ground aggregate storage capacity of 1,320 gallons (24 55-gallon drums); or a single above ground container of 660 gallons. For more information, I am enclosing a guidance sheet on Understanding the Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure Requirements.

## **Universal Waste**

As a reminder, Universal Wastes, such as fluorescent bulbs, are specific hazardous waste streams that a generator can choose to manage in an alternative manner in place of more complex hazardous waste requirements. Universal Wastes are generated by

numerous businesses, typically in small quantities. The Universal Waste Rules are intended to promote recycling and stop illegal disposal by easing certain regulatory requirements.

Do not simply throw through florescent bulbs in the trash. Be reminded that even if a bulb company promotes a bulb as being "green" or "environmentally friendly," the bulb may be hazardous. Please see the enclosed guidance on Universal Waste.


### Conclusion
