Dear Randy Parker:

I am writing to notify you that I received the 2008 Hazardous Waste Annual Report for your site on October 21, 2009. This report was requested by me in a letter dated September 24, 2009 indicating that Shiloh Industries, Inc. had not submitted a report for hazardous wastes generated during 2008. The letter stated the waste totals incorrectly – the shipments reported from Ohio TSDFs should have been stated as 25.88 T for a total quantity of 26.84 T when combined with Michigan manifest data of 0.96 T. This site was still a large quantity generator for 2008. The report has been processed and entered into Ohio EPA's Annual Report database, and the violation has been abated.
