Dear Mr. McCabe:

On June 1, 2009, Ohio EPA conducted a financial record review for the Environmental Enterprise Incorporated (EEI), Cincinnati, Ohio facility. I evaluated the facility for compliance with financial assurance and liability requirements for closure care set forth in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-55-42, 3745-55-43 and 3745-55-47 and Permit Conditions B.33, B.34 and B.35.

In a June 4, 2009 letter EEI was cited in violation of OAC rule 3745-55-42 and Permit Condition B.33(b) and (d) because EEI has failed to adjust the closure cost estimate for inflation .

On June 10, 2009, EEI submitted a Class 1 modification to the Part B Hazardous Waste Permit Application to reflect the updated detail closure cost estimate. Also, EEI submitted an updated financial assurance mechanism to reflect the closure cost estimate adjustment. Therefore, **EEI has abated the above violations.** However, EEI should include third-party liability coverage, i.e. hazardous waste certificate of insurance, as part of the Class 1 permit modification.
