Thank you for your response to Ohio EPA's August 3, 2011 Notice of Violation (NOV). Your response was received on September 9, 2011.

The documentation you submitted included the following:

1. Photographs showing labeled drums of used oil.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the documentation and determined that it is sufficient to correct the violation listed in the NOV:

- 1. Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators (Labels)
OAC 3745-279-22(C)**

Containers and above ground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil"

Please note that the rule specifies that containers of used oil must be labeled "Used Oil". Your labels say "Waste Oil". You must make sure that all future labels say "Used Oil".

No response to this letter is required.

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve AAMCO from the responsibility of complying with all applicable Ohio EPA laws and regulations. Please be advised that present or past instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.
