Dear Mr. Lechaix:

Thank you for your September 8, 2010, response to Ohio EPA's August 26, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted indicates National Printing and Packaging will be managing its ink contaminated rags as a hazardous waste. It further indicates that spent lamps will be managed as universal waste. **Please be advised, however, that universal wastes may be accumulated at the property for no longer than one year.** Enclosed you will find a copy of Ohio EPA's publication *Universal Waste Rules for Handlers of Lamps*.

My review of this documentation reveals that National Printing and Packaging has now abated all violations discovered during the August 6, 2010, inspection as listed below.
