Dear Mr. Burton:

On November 5, 2007, the Ohio EPA received a response to your ongoing effort to Return to Compliance. Your response included documentation regarding tank inspections, ancillary equipment and a tank inspection log. A receipt for scrap metal recycling of the former wastewater treatment system and generator closure information was also included.

Review of this information indicates that all cited violations have been adequately abated including:

- 5) Tank Inspections, OAC 3745-66-95 (A)(1) to (A)(4), and
- 6) Containment and detection of releases, OAC 3745-66-93(E)(1), and
- 7) Ancillary Equipment Requirements, OAC 3745-66-93 (F).

COMMENT and CONCERN

Documentation that you provided appears to indicate that you have adequately performed closure of the temporary generator hazardous waste tank storage area and decontamination of equipment and surfaces. The effort appears to meet the closure performance standards of DHWM's Closure Plan Review Guidance.

Please keep in mind that your new hazardous waste tank system requires a written assessment and secondary containment certification for construction, installation and design per the tank system requirements of OAC 3745-52-34(A) and 3745-66-100.
