Dear Mr. Agin:

On April 12, 2010, Kris Coder and I inspected the Agmet Oakwood facility to determine its compliance with its variance, and the Ohio hazardous waste and used oil rules and laws as found in Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code and Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code. On April 30, 2010, I sent you a letter concerning our inspection and requesting additional information so that we could complete our evaluation. On May 5, 2010 we received additional information from Fred Warren that included the current training matrix and the updates to the contingency plan.

Based on our inspection and a review of your records, we noted the following violation.

Variance Condition 2.g. - Employee Training

"Each employee shall be trained ...once within every 12 months...with regard to his or her duties as they pertain to spill response, facility inspections, Variance Material handling, Variance Material specifications and emergency response. Documentation of training shall be signed by the employee and retained on-site at Oakwood..."

According to the training matrix, most of the employees have not had all of their required training within the past 12 months.

- Employee #3 has not had modules 1 and 3.
- Employee #6 has not had module 5.
- Employee #10 has not had modules 2, 4, and 5.
- Employee #12 has not had modules 2, 4, and 5.
- Employee #14 has not had module 5.
- Employee #15 has not had modules 4 and 5.
- Employee #16 has not had modules 4 and 5.
- Employee #20 has not had modules 4 and 5.
- Employee #22 has not had modules 4 and 5.
- Employee #31 has not had module 5.

Please provide the indicated modules immediately to these employees. Also employees # 7, 11, 18, and 19 have the word 'gone' crossed out by their name. Please clarify if these employees are currently employed by Agmet. If they are, their training requirements need to be met as well.

Submit within 30 days of the date of this letter the completed training matrix noting for each required module the date it was completed by each employee.


