Thank you for your September 2, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's August 16, 2011 Notice of Violation (NOV). The documentation you submitted included the following:

1. Pictures showing used oil drums have been properly labeled.
2. An explanation that AllTech will begin accumulating used lamps in boxes and sending them to a recycler when the boxes are full. Currently, AllTech has no lamps on the premises.

The documentation you submitted is sufficient to correct the violation cited in the NOV (listed below) and the concern about the management of universal waste lamps:

- 1. Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators (Labels)  
OAC 3745-279-22(C)**


