
On August 23, 2011, I received ASK Chemicals' response to Ohio EPA's July 22, 2011 Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC) letter. The following is the status of the previously cited violations:

1. ORC § 3734.02(F), Causing A Hazardous Waste To Be Transported To An Unpermitted Facility: To prevent a recurrence of this violation, ASK Chemicals provided training to all relevant employees on hazardous waste determination, manifest use, labeling and marking of containers, land disposal restriction (LDR) requirements, as well as a comprehensive training course on RCRA requirements. **This violation has been adequately addressed. No further response is requested.**
2. OAC rule 3745-52-34(A)(2), Dating Hazardous Waste Accumulation Containers: This violation was previously addressed.
3. OAC rule 3745-52-41(A)(5), Annual Report: On August 5, 2011, ASK Chemicals re-submitted the annual hazardous waste report to include all hazardous waste shipped off-site in calendar year 2010. **This violation has been adequately addressed. No further response is requested.**
4. OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)(1), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators: This violation was previously addressed.

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve ASK Chemicals from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
