Dear Mr. Horval:

On November 25, 2009, I spoke with Terry Kingsmill with AT& T as a follow-up to the October 28, 2009 compliance evaluation inspection conducted at the AT&T facility in Medina, Ohio. Specifically, I spoke to Mr. Kingsmill regarding where the spent fluorescent lamps and used oil are taken for disposal. Mr. Kingsmill indicated that the few lamps generated at the AT&T facility in Medina are taken to an AT&T facility in Cleveland to be sent off site for final management. This management practice for the lamps is acceptable.

Mr. Kingston and I had a more involved discussion regarding the used oil management. Mr. Kingston clarified the source of the waste that had previously been identified as used oil. Mr. Kingston stated that the oily material is actually unburned fuel from the generator. Mr. Kingston stated that he takes the fuel home to burn in his tiki lamps. Since it is a fuel and is being used as a fuel, the material is not a used oil and therefore the following violation was cited in error in the November 6, 2009 notice of violation letter and is hereby retracted:

1. ***Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)***

Mr. Kingston stated that he would remove the "used oil" labels from the containers and re-label the containers identifying the contents.

Failure to list specific deficiencies and or violations in this communication does not relieve AT&T Corp. from the responsibility of complying with all applicable laws, rules and regulations.
