
On April 20, 2011, I received Avon Concrete Corporation's (Avon Concrete) response to Ohio EPA's April 13, 2011 Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC) letter. Subsequently, on May 6 and June 6, 2011, Avon Concrete submitted the results of the waste characterization testing for the used oil contaminated material, as well as waste shipment information.

The following is the status of the previously cited violation:

1. OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)(1)(D), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators
  - A. This violation was previously abated.
  - B. Avon Concrete's April 20, May 6 and June 6, 2011 responses included documentation that the used oil release from the Concrete Block Casting Pad was cleaned up, characterized and subsequently disposed off site at an appropriate facility. **Based upon submitted documentation, this violation has been adequately abated. No further response is requested.**
