Dear Mr. Yoder:

Thank you for accompanying me during Ohio EPA's October 19, 2010, compliance inspection of Berlin Wood Products (BWP) at 5039 County Rd. 120, Berlin, Ohio. I inspected BWP to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). I also inspected BWP for compliance with Ohio's universal waste and used oil rules.

BWP is a manufacturer of wood components and wood products such as cedar chests, children's toys such as wooden wagons, etc. The facility generates spent solvent hazardous waste (D001) from a paint booth. The majority (95%) of the painting done at the facility is with water based paint, with the remainder (primarily varnish) solvent based. According to facility records, BWP generates approximately 5 gallons per year of the waste solvent and varnish hazardous waste. The hazardous waste is managed by Safety-Kleen. The facility is currently a conditionally exempt small quantity generator of hazardous waste.

BWP also generates small quantities of used oil from facility equipment. At the time of the inspection you indicated that the used oil is currently transported off-site to another facility owned by your "friend" where it's burned in a used oil heater. Universal waste lamps are also generated. Enclosed you will find a copy of the checklists that I completed as a result of the inspection.

The following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste and used oil laws were found during this inspection. In order to correct these violations you must do the following and send me the required information ***within 30 days*** of the date of this letter:

1. Universal Waste Lamp Labeling, OAC 3745-273-14 (E):

Universal waste lamps or containers or packages of lamps must be labeled with the words "Universal Waste - Lamp(s)" or "Waste Lamp(s)" or "Used Lamp(s)". At the time of my inspection the boxes of the waste lamps were not labeled. Please submit a picture documenting the waste lamps or their containers are properly labeled and indicate in your written response how waste lamp handling procedures have been changed to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation.

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2. Universal Waste Accumulation Time, OAC 3745-273-15(A):

Universal waste can be accumulated for one year, unless the waste is accumulated over one year in order to facilitate proper recovery, treatment or disposal. At the time of my inspection, you indicated that waste lamps had last been shipped off site to Sunpro for recycling 4 to 5 years ago. Some of the waste lamps being accumulated have been accumulated for longer than one year. This is in violation of OAC 3745-273-15(A). To return to compliance with this regulation have all waste lamps shipped to an approved lamp recycler and submit a copy of the associated shipping papers.


3. Prohibitions on Used Oil Fuel Marketers, OAC 3745-279-71(A)(B):

A used oil fuel marketer may only ship off-specification used oil to a used oil burner who:
(A) Has a U.S. EPA identification number; and (B) Burns the used oil in an industrial furnace or boiler identified in OAC rule 3745-279-61(A).

BWP shipped off-specification used oil to a facility where it was burned in a used oil space heater. Used oil space heaters are not considered an industrial furnace or boiler. As a result of the off-specification used oil shipment, BWP also violated OAC rules 3745-279-12(C), 3745-279-24, 3745-279-73(A), 3745-279-74(A)(1) through (A)(5) and 3745-279-75(A). To return to compliance with these regulations indicate that BWP will no longer ship used oil to the off-site burner without an analysis of each shipment indicating the oil meets the used oil specification listed in Table 1 of OAC 3745-279-11 (see enclosure *Burning Oil in Space Heaters*). Alternatively, indicate in your response that the oil will be transported to a recycling facility.
