Dear Mr. Vitanza:

I have received your July 26, 2010 e-mail regarding the management of your waste fluorescent lamps. This was in response to the violations found during the March 15, 2010 inspection of Cast Nylons located at 4300 Hamann Pkwy, Willoughby, Ohio. As outlined below, you have documented a correction of all the violations and concerns found during the inspection.

1. OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.
Your July 26, 2010 e-mail documents your correction of this violation.
2. OAC rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.
Previously corrected.

On August 11, 2010, I met with you at Cast Nylons. We discussed the five containers that I had asked you about in my March 31, 2010 letter. You showed me the MSDS for these materials and told me you are working on setting up disposal of these materials. Based on the MSDS, it appears these are not hazardous wastes.
